#### THE GOSPEL IN CHURCH Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> November 2022



Jesus said to his disciples, "As it was in Noah's day, so will it be when the Son of Man comes. For in those days before the Flood people were eating, drinking and having a good time, right up to the day
